






#### VICTIM DEMOGRAPHICS














#### **OFFENDER DEMOGRAPHICS**








#### **PRIMARY LANGUAGE**




# IDENTIFICATION OF HIGH RISK CASES TOTAL TO

#### **GREATER NEWBURYPORT DVHRT REFERRALS**







#### **CRIMINAL JUSTICE OUTCOMES**

At the time of this report, 99% of the high risk cases receiving criminal justice intervention have been disposed. In 64% of high risk cases, the time between arraignment and disposition was three months or less, and 94% of cases were resolved within six months.



<sup>\*</sup> Of the 172 high risk cases, 79% received criminal justice intervention after the case was accepted by the DVHRT.
